I am a graduating high school student in Romania. In September I will start studying Eastern Cultures and Languages in Budapest. As a high school student, I ended all my semesters with the highest possible rating – 10. At the end of the last school year I got the „Magis Prize”, which is the school’s biggest reward, given only for 2 students from the whole institution consisting of more than 600 people. I won two times in a row the „National Academic Competition of Biblical Studies”, prized by the Romanian State. I took part at different literature competitions, getting 5 international prize, national rewards and special gifts. I took part in the Hungarian Templeton Program, a community that has been formed to develop 315 exceptional cognitive talents from 20.000 applicants. During the one year scholarship I represented the program at the EP meeting in Brussels, visited Switzerland, but also took part at the European Youth Summit and the ECHA Conference in Vienna. After the establishment of the Youth Platform by the European Talent Support Network, I was elected as the representative of the community twice – my second mandate will end in December 2018. As the Youth Platform representative, I had a lecture at the Slovakian EU presidency talent support conference. I also took part at the second meeting of the European Talent Centres on the 28th of October 2016 in Budapest.

During my mandate, my aim is to bring the Youth Platform to a new level, cooperate with young talents from many countries and start a social entrepreneurship project, which helps underprivileged young children to develop.
